# Before and After School Club

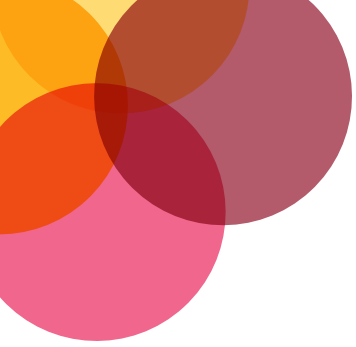
Here at Lostock Hall Primary School we provide a very popular Before and After School Club.
